The Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) has reviewed the July 2024 document titled Site Characterization Report – Tank Group 02 for the incident referenced above. This document was prepared by Terraphase Engineering and submitted as a release investigation report (RIRNO). DEP approves the RIRNO which documents that the contamination associated with incident no. 56377 will be evaluated as part of the Act 2 remediation efforts associated with eFACTS primary facility identification nos. 778374, 778376, and 880321. Therefore, DEP has administratively closed incident no. 56377.

DEP reserves the right to require additional site characterization and/or remediation if information is submitted demonstrating the presence of additional contamination beyond what was reported in the RIRNO associated with incident no. 56377. DEP also reserves all rights to take any enforcement action in the future if necessary.
