The No. 3 Separator Remediation System was a 10-well total fluids recovery system installed by Evergreen Resources Management Operations (Evergreen) in 2012 to address light non-aqueous phase liquid (LNAPL) from a prior release in the area of the property along the Schuylkill River near the No. 3 oil-water separator. In 2013, Bellwether District Holdings, LLC (BDH), formerly known as Philadelphia Energy Solutions Refining and Marketing LLC (PESRM), assumed primary responsibility for the No. 3 Separator Remediation System due to petroleum releases from a process sewer system, which connected the 137 Unit to the No. 4 Separator. The future use of the property is expected to be non-residential.

Provide a general description of proposed remediation measures.

BDH continued to operate and monitor the recovery system until October 2021. Increases in LNAPL thicknesses were periodically observed in the monitoring and recovery wells associated with the system between 2013 and October 2021. After the shutdown of the plant air, skimmer pumps were used to continue to remove measurable LNAPL from the monitoring and recovery wells associated with the No. 3 Separator Remediation System. Stantec Consulting Services, Inc. (Stantec), on behalf of BDH, previously conducted bi-weekly LNAPL gauging of the monitoring and recovery wells. LNAPL levels have been generally stable in the monitoring and recovery wells in this area since December 2021. One well in the area, C-169, has reported fluctuations in LNAPL levels in 2022 through 2024. During the most recent gauging event in January 2025, measurable LNAPL was not reported in C-169.

The former storm and process sewer believed to be the source of residual oil to groundwater in the area was cleaned and abandoned in place by filling with flowable fill in February 2025. Terraphase is conducting groundwater and LNAPL monitoring in Spring 2025 to verify conditions after the sewer abandonment.


