Contamination, Land Usage, and Proposed Remediation Section

LNAPL has been observed in monitoring well S-122SRTF periodically since at least 2016. Forensic analysis completed in 2024, indicated the LNAPL to be a mixture of leaded gasoline (estimated release pre-1988), unleaded gasoline (estimated release pre-2010), and a diesel-type component (estimated release between 2004 and 2016). The specific mechanism of release is unconfirmed. The facility is currently idle and the future use will be non-residential.

Although the specific mechanism of release is not known, based on available data, the release does not appear to be associated with discrete releases from ASTs that have been demolished and removed, or from remaining tanks, most of which are empty.

The current and intended future use of the site is industrial/commercial.

Provide a general description of proposed remediation measures.

Bellwether District Holdings, LLC (BDH) is currently planning the necessary activities to evaluate the potential post-2012 contamination located near well S-122SRTF to the non-residential statewide health standard. LNAPL that was released prior to September 8, 2012 is also present in this area. Remedial options are being evaluated; however, they may include LNAPL collection and recovery and use of engineering and institutional controls.


